INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

KNOW YE, that whereas, the *Protocol to Implement the Tenth Package of Commitments on Air Transport Services under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services* was signed by the Member States of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) on 13 October 2017 in Singapore;

WHEREAS, the Protocol provides that the ASEAN Member States shall accord preferential treatment to one another in air transport services on a Most-Favoured-Nation basis, subject to each Member State's Schedules of Specific Commitments and the Lists of Most-Favoured-Nation Exemptions; and


NOW, THEREFORE, be it known that I, **RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE**, President of the Republic of the Philippines, after having seen and considered the *Protocol to Implement the Tenth Package of Commitments on Air Transport Services under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services*, do hereby ratify and confirm the same and each and every article and clause thereof.
