NOTIFICATION OF ADHERENCE TO THE AGREEMENT
ON THE ASEAN FOOD SECURITY RESERVE

WHEREAS the Declaration of the Admission of Brunei Darussalam into the Association of South-East Asian Nations (ASEAN) was done in Jakarta on 7th January 1984 whereby Brunei Darussalam became the sixth member of ASEAN;

AND WHEREAS by the said Declaration Brunei Darussalam solemnly agreed to subscribe or accede as the case may be to all the Declarations and Treaties of ASEAN;

NOW THEREFORE the Government of Brunei Darussalam hereby gives notice that Brunei Darussalam desires to subscribe and be treated as a party to the Agreement on the ASEAN Food Security Reserve signed in the City of New York, United States of America on 4th October 1979.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I, Prince Mohamed Bolkiah, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Brunei Darussalam have hereunto set my hand and affixed the National Seal of Brunei Darussalam.
