**INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION
PROTOCOL TO IMPLEMENT
THE EIGHTH PACKAGE OF COMMITMENTS ON FINANCIAL SERVICES
UNDER THE ASEAN FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT ON SERVICES**

WHEREAS the Protocol to Implement the Eighth Package of Commitments on Financial Services under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services (hereinafter referred to as the "Protocol") was signed on behalf of the Government of Brunei Darussalam at Chiang Rai, Thailand on 5 April 2019;

AND WHEREAS paragraph 8 of the Protocol provides that each Member State shall, upon the completion of its internal procedures of ratification or acceptance of this Protocol and its Annexes, deposit its instrument of Ratification or Acceptance with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Dato Erywan Pehin Yusof, Minister of Foreign Affairs II, declare that the Government of Brunei Darussalam, having considered the Protocol hereby ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained,
