INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

PROTOCOL ON NOTIFICATION PROCEDURES

WHEREAS the Protocol on Notification Procedures was signed at Makati City, Philippines on 7 October 1998 by the duly authorized Representatives of the Governments of Brunei Darussalam, the Republic of Indonesia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, the Union of Myanmar, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam;

WHEREAS Article 8(4) provides that the Agreement shall enter into force upon the deposit of the instruments of ratification or acceptance by all the signatory Governments with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Brunei Darussalam having considered the said Protocol, hereby formally ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations contained therein.
