INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Protocol 5 on ASEAN Scheme of Compulsory Motor Vehicle Insurance was signed in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on the 8th day of April 2001 by the duly authorized Representatives of the Governments of Brunei Darussalam, the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Republic of Indonesia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, the Union of Myanmar, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam;

AND WHEREAS paragraph 4 of Article 15 of the Protocol provides that it shall enter into force upon the deposit of Instruments of Ratification or Acceptance by all Contracting Parties with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;
