INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

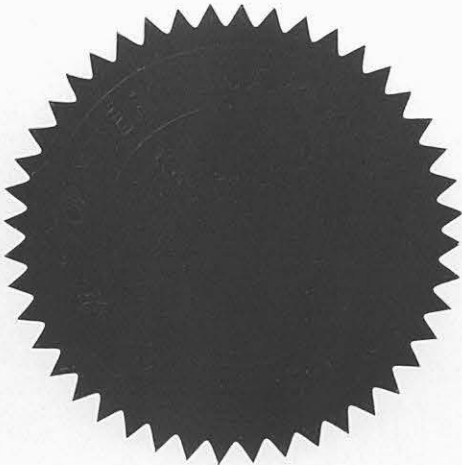
