INSTRUMENT OF ACCEPTANCE

to the Protocol to Implement the Fourth Package of Commitments on Financial Services under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services

WHEREAS the Protocol to Implement the Fourth Package of Commitments on Financial Services under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services was signed by the duly authorized representative of the Government of the Lao People's Democratic Republic in Da Nang, Viet Nam, on 4th April 2008;

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 6 of the Protocol stipulates that Member Countries undertake to complete their respective internal procedures for the entry into force of this Protocol; and Paragraph 8 provides that the Each Member Country shall, upon the completion of its internal procedures, notify the ASEAN Secretariat in writing;

NOW THEREFORE I, Thongloun SISOULITH, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs, declare that the Government of the Lao People's Democratic Republic, having considered the above-mentioned Protocol, accepts the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.
