
INSTRUMENT OF ACCEPTANCE


to the Protocol to Implement the Fourth Package of Commitments under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services

WHEREAS the Protocol to Implement the Fourth Package of Commitments under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services was signed by the duly authorized representative of the Government of the Lao People's Democratic Republic in Jakarta, Indonesia, on 3 September 2004;

AND WHEREAS Point 5 of the said Protocol stipulates that this Protocol shall enter into force upon the deposit of Instruments of Ratification or Acceptance by all signatory governments with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

NOW THEREFORE I, Thongloun SISOULITH, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs, declare that the Lao People's Democratic Republic, having considered the above-mentioned Protocol, accepts the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.
