The Permanent Mission of Malaysia to ASEAN would like to refer to the second and third paragraph of the above-mentioned Instrument of Ratification and hereby wishes to convey that the said paragraphs should read as follows:

"AND WHEREAS Article 22 of the Agreement provides that the Agreement shall enter into force on 1 January 2015 and shall be in force only among the Member States that have ratified and/or accepted it."

"NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Malaysia, having considered the Agreement, hereby notifies the other Parties of Malaysia's completion of its internal requirements necessary for entry into force of the Agreement."

The Permanent Mission of Malaysia to ASEAN would appreciate the assistance of the ASEAN Secretariat to notify the other Contracting Parties that Malaysia has deposited the Instrument of Ratification of the Agreement with the ASEAN Secretariat.

The Permanent Mission of Malaysia to ASEAN avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the ASEAN Secretariat the assurances of its highest consideration.

INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION
