

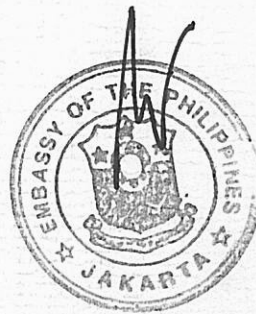

INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

KNOW YE, that whereas, the *Agreement on the Establishment of the ASEAN Centre for Biodiversity* was signed by the Philippines along with other ASEAN countries;

WHEREAS, the *Agreement* establishes the *ASEAN Centre for Biodiversity* and identifies the Philippines as the host country for the Centre. The *Agreement* aims to facilitate cooperation among the members of ASEAN, and with relevant national governments, regional and international organizations, on the conservation and sustainable use of biological diversity and the fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising from the use of such biodiversity in the ASEAN region;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it known that **I, GLORIA MACAPAGAL ARROYO**, President of the Republic of the Philippines, after having seen and considered the aforementioned *Agreement on the Establishment of the ASEAN Centre for Biodiversity*, do hereby ratify and confirm the same and each and every Article and Clause thereof.
