WHEREAS the Agreement on the Establishment of the ASEAN Tourism Information Centre was signed in Kuala Lumpur on 26 September 1988 by the Governments of Brunei Darussalam, the Republic of Indonesia, Malaysia, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore and the Kingdom of Thailand;
