INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Third Protocol amending the Treaty of Amity and Cooperation in Southeast Asia was adopted at Hanoi on the twenty third day of July in the year two thousand and ten;

AND WHEREAS on behalf of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, Dr. Dipu Moni, MP, Foreign Minister of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, signed the protocol on the twenty third day of July in the year two thousand and ten;
