

INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

ASEAN CONVENTION AGAINST TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS, ESPECIALLY WOMEN AND CHILDREN

WHEREAS, the ASEAN Convention Against Trafficking in Persons, Especially Women and Children was signed by the Government of Brunei Darussalam in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on 21 November 2015 and entered into force on 8 March 2017;

AND WHEREAS, Article 29 of the Convention provides that the said Convention shall be subject to ratification or approval in accordance with the internal procedures of the Parties;

NOW THEREFORE I, DATO ERYWAN PEHIN YUSOF, Minister of Foreign Affairs II, declare that the Government of Brunei Darussalam, having considered the said ASEAN Convention Against Trafficking in Persons, Especially Women and Children, hereby, ratifies to the said Convention and undertake to faithfully perform and carry out the stipulations contained therein.
