**INSTRUMENT OF ACCEPTANCE
OF THE AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING THE
ASEAN PROMOTION CENTRE
ON TRADE, INVESTMENT AND TOURISM**

WHEREAS the Agreement Establishing the ASEAN Promotion Centre on Trade, Investment and Tourism was signed by Japan and Member Countries of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) in Tokyo, on 22 December 1980;

WHEREAS the Article XXI of the Agreement provides that the amendments to this Agreement shall come into force upon the adoption by the Council. However, the amendments involving "the introduction of new obligations for Members" shall require subsequent acceptance by all Members before they come into force;

NOW THEREFORE the Royal Government of Cambodia, having considered and accepted the amendments to the Agreement as adopted by the Council on 20 November 2007, undertakes faithfully to carry out the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have signed this Instrument of Acceptance and affixed hereunto the seal of the Royal Government of Cambodia.
