INSTRUMENT OF NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, the First Protocol to Amend the Agreement on Comprehensive Economic Partnership among Member States of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations and Japan was signed on 27 February, 2 March and 24 April 2019 respectively;

AND WHEREAS Article 8 of Chapter 10 of the Protocol provides that the Government of each signatory State shall notify the Governments of other signatory States in writing that its legal procedures necessary for entry into force of this Protocol have been completed. This Protocol shall enter into force on the first day of the second month following the date by which such notifications have been made by the Governments of at least one (1) ASEAN Member State and Japan in relation to those signatory States that have made such notifications by that date;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Aung San Suu Kyi, Union Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, declare that the Government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, having considered the said Protocol notifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained;

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have signed this Instrument of Notification and affixed hereto my seal.
