INSTRUMENT OF NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS the Second Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Comprehensive Investment Agreement (hereinafter referred to as “the Second Protocol”) was signed in Ha Noi, Viet Nam on 21 September 2017.

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 1 of Article 3 of the Second Protocol provides that the Second Protocol shall enter into force after all Member States have notified the completion of their respective internal procedures for the entry into force of this Second Protocol to, or, where necessary, deposited instruments of ratification or acceptance with, the Secretary-General of ASEAN.

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Malaysia, having considered the Second Protocol, hereby notifies the other Parties of Malaysia’s completion of its internal procedures necessary for entry into force of this Second Protocol.
