## **INSTRUMENT OF NOTIFICATION**

**WHEREAS** the Third Protocol to Amend the Agreement on Trade in Goods under the Framework Agreement on Comprehensive Economic Cooperation among the Governments of Member Countries of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations and the Republic of Korea (hereinafter referred to as "the Protocol") was signed in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on 22 November 2015.

**AND WHEREAS** Paragraph 2 of Article 10 of the Protocol provides that each Party, upon the completion of its internal procedures for the entry into force on this Protocol, shall notify all the other Parties in writing.
