INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the ASEAN Multilateral Agreement on the Full Liberalisation of Passenger Air Services (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") was signed on 12 November 2010 in Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam;

AND WHEREAS the Agreement was signed on behalf of the Government of Malaysia on the same date;

AND WHEREAS Article 19, paragraph 2 of the Agreement provides that the Agreement is subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties and the Instrument of Ratification or Acceptance shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of ASEAN who shall promptly inform each Contracting Party of such deposit;

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Malaysia, having considered the abovementioned Agreement, ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITHNESS THEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Malaysia.
