## INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

**WHEREAS** the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Visa Exemption (hereinafter referred to as 'the Agreement') was signed in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on 25 July 2006.

**WHEREAS** Article 8(1) of the Agreement provides that this Agreement is subject to the ratification or approval by all Member Countries in accordance with their respective domestic laws and regulations;

**WHEREAS** Article 8(2) of the Agreement provides that the instruments of ratification or approval of this Agreement shall be communicated to the Secretary-General of ASEAN who shall promptly inform other Member Countries of such deposit; and

**WHEREAS** Article 8(3) of the Agreement provides that this Agreement shall come into force when instruments of ratification or approval of all Member Countries have been deposited.

**WHEREAS, THE GOVERNMENT OF MALAYSIA**, having considered the Agreement, hereby ratifies the same and undertakes to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.

**IN WITNESS THEREOF**, this Instrument of Ratification is signed, sealed and deposited with the Secretary-General of ASEAN by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia.
