INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION


WHEREAS, the ASEAN Convention Against Trafficking in Persons, Especially Women and Children was signed in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, on 21 November 2015;

AND WHEREAS, Article 28 of the aforesaid Convention stipulates that this Convention shall be subject to ratification or approval in accordance with the internal procedures of the Parties;
