INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

KNOW YE, that whereas, the *Second Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Comprehensive Investment Agreement (ACIA)* was signed on 21 September 2017 in Hanoi, Vietnam;

WHEREAS, the signing and implementation of the Second Protocol will clarify the treatment of natural persons among ASEAN Member States, particularly on permanent residents, considering the different regimes within the region; and

WHEREAS, the signing and implementation of the Second Protocol entails no additional cost to the Philippines since the provisions contained therein are consistent and in conformity with the intent of the ACIA;
