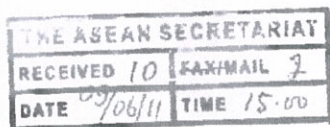

INSTRUMENT OF NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS Protocol 1 on Unlimited Third and Fourth Freedom Traffic Rights Between Any Points in Contracting Parties ("Protocol 1") of the Air Transport Agreement between the Governments of the Member States of ASEAN and the Government of the People's Republic of China was opened for signature at Brunei Darussalam on 12 November 2010,

AND WHEREAS Protocol 1 has been signed on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Singapore on 12 November 2010,

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 2 of Article 3 of Protocol 1 provides that each Contracting Party shall give written notification to the Depositary upon completion of its relevant internal legal procedures necessary for the entry into force of the Agreement,

NOW THEREFORE I, K Shanmugam, Minister for Foreign Affairs declare that the Government of the Republic of Singapore having considered the Agreement, hereby notifies the Depositary that the Government of the Republic of Singapore has completed its relevant internal legal procedures necessary for the entry into force of Protocol 1.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have signed this instrument of notification in Singapore on 27 May 2011.
