INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the ASEAN Agreement on Customs (the "Agreement") was signed on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Singapore at Phnom Penh on 30 March 2012,

AND WHEREAS Article 63(1) of the Agreement provides that the Agreement shall enter into force after all ASEAN Member States have notified or, where necessary, deposited instruments of ratification with the Secretary General of ASEAN upon completion of their internal procedures,
