INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the ASEAN Multilateral Agreement on the Full Liberalisation of Passenger Air Services was signed at Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam, on 12 November 2010, by the duly authorised Representatives of the Governments of Brunei Darussalam, the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Republic of Indonesia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, the Union of Myanmar, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam;

WHEREAS Article 19, paragraph 2, of the Agreement stipulates that this Agreement is subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties. The Instruments of Ratification or Acceptance shall be deposited with the Depositary (the Secretary-General of ASEAN) and the Depositary shall promptly inform each Contracting Party of such deposit;

WHEREAS Article 19, paragraph 3, of the Agreement stipulates that this Agreement shall enter into force on the date of the deposit of the third (3rd) Instrument of Ratification or Acceptance with the Depository and shall become effective only among the Contracting Parties that have ratified, or accepted it; and

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND, having considered the aforesaid Agreement, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations contained therein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

DONE at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this ^{2nd}Day of September in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Fifty-four of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Eleven of the Christian Era.
