## **INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION**

WHEREAS the ASEAN Convention on Counter Terrorism was signed by the duly authorised Representative of the Kingdom of Thailand on 13 January 2007;

WHEREAS Article XX paragraph 1 of the Convention provides that the Convention shall be subject to ratification or approval in accordance with the internal procedures of the Parties; and

WHEREAS Article II paragraph 2 of the Convention provides that on depositing its instrument of ratification or approval, a Party which is not a Party to a treaty listed in paragraph 1 of Article II may declare that, in the application of this Convention to that Party, that treaty shall be deemed not to be included in paragraph 1 of Article II, and that the declaration shall cease to have an effect as soon as the treaty enters into force for the Party having made such a declaration, which shall notify the depository as stated in paragraph 2 of Article XX of this entry into force;

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND, having considered the aforesaid Convention, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations contained therein, subject to the following declaration:

"In accordance with Article II paragraph 2 of the Convention, the Kingdom of Thailand hereby declares that in the application of this Convention to the Kingdom of Thailand, the following treaties, to which the Kingdom of Thailand is not a party, shall be deemed not to be included in paragraph 1 of Article II:

- 1. Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material, adopted in Vienna on 26 October 1979;
- 2. Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts Against the Safety of Maritime Navigation, done at Rome on 10 March 1988;
- 3. Protocol for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts Against the Safety of Fixed Platforms Located on the Continental Shelf, done at Rome on 10 March 1988;
- 4. International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism, adopted in New York on 13 April 2005;
- 5. Amendment to the Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material, done at Vienna on 8 July 2005;
- 6. Protocol of 2005 to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts Against the Safety of Maritime Navigation, done at London on 14 October 2005; and
- 7. Protocol of 2005 to the Protocol for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts Against the Safety of Fixed Platforms Located on the Continental Shelf, done at London on 14 October 2005."

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

Done at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 21st day of February in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Fifty-one of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Eight of the Christian Era.
