Instrument of Ratification

WHEREAS the Revised Memorandum of Understanding on the Establishment of the ASEAN Foundation was done at Bangkok on 25 July 2000 by the duly authorized Representatives of the Governments of Brunei Darussalam, the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Republic of Indonesia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, the Union of Myanmar, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam; and

WHEREAS Article XVII of the aforesaid Revised Memorandum of Understanding stipulates that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force upon deposit of instruments of ratification or letters of acceptance by all signatory governments with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND, having considered the aforesaid Revised Memorandum of Understanding, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations contained therein, subject to the interpretative declaration with regard to its Article III paragraph 1 that the Foundation shall have legal personality only in the Host Country.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.
