INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Fourth Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Comprehensive Investment Agreement was done at Ha Noi, the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam, on 15 July 2020;


WHEREAS Article 5, paragraph 1 of the Protocol stipulates that this Protocol shall enter into force after all Member States have notified the completion of their respective internal procedures for the entry into force of this Protocol to, or, where necessary, deposited instruments of ratification or acceptance with, the Secretary-General of ASEAN; and

WHEREAS Article 5, paragraph 2 of the Protocol stipulates that the Secretary-General of ASEAN shall promptly notify all Member States of the notifications or deposit of each instrument of ratification or acceptance;

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND, having considered the aforesaid Protocol, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations contained therein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

DONE at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 29th Day of September in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Sixty-three of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Twenty of the Christian Era.
