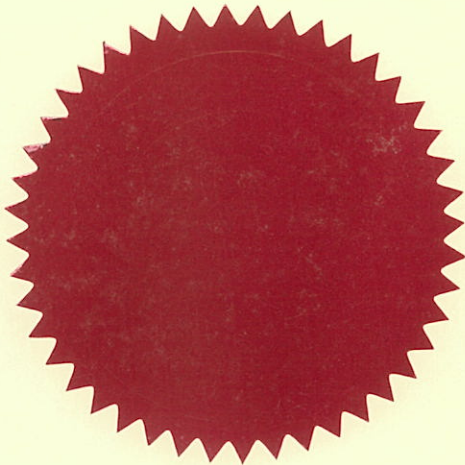
INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION
