**INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION**


**WHEREAS** the Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Mutual Recognition Arrangement on Tourism Professionals was signed in Vientiane on 24 June 2022 by the duly authorized representative of the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand; and

**WHEREAS** Article III, paragraph 1 stipulates that the Protocol shall enter into force after all Member States have deposited their instrument of ratification, acceptance or approval with the Secretary-General of ASEAN upon the completion of their internal procedures;

**THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND**, having considered the aforesaid Protocol, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

**DONE** at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 9<sup>th</sup> day of September in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Sixty-five of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Twenty-two of the Christian Era.
