INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS ASEAN Food Safety Regulatory Framework (AFSRF) Agreement was signed on 12th January 2024 in Nonthaburi, Thailand.

AND WHEREAS Article 18 of the AFSRF Agreement states that the Agreement shall enter into force on the date of the deposit of the Instrument of Ratification, Approval, or Acceptance by the tenth Member State with Secretary-General of ASEAN.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Than Swe, Deputy Prime Minister and Union Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, declare that the Government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, having considered the aforesaid Agreement, ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained;
