INSTRUMENT OF ACCEPTANCE

WHEREAS the Second Amendment to the Agreement Establishing the ASEAN Promotion Centre on Trade, Investment and Tourism ("Second Amendment") was adopted in Tokyo, Japan on June 2024;

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 1 of the Second Amendment amended Article X2 of the Agreement Establishing the ASEAN Promotion Centre on Trade, Investment and Tourism ("Agreement") to provide that the annual budget of the ASEAN Promotion Centre on Trade, Investment and Tourism ("Centre") shall be financed in the proportions specified in the Annex to the Second Amendment ("Annex"), except for the rent of the permanent ASEAN Trade, Investment and Tourism Exhibition Hall, which shall be borne by Japan;

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 1 of the Second Amendment further amended Article X2 of the Agreement to provide that the Annex shall form an integral part of the Agreement, and that any Member may propose amendments to the Annex, which shall enter into force upon adoption by the Council;

AND WHEREAS the Annex provides that the Second Amendment shall enter into force on the date on which the Depository Authorities (the Government of Japan and the ASEAN Secretariat) have received the instruments of acceptance from all Member Countries, in accordance with Article XXI3 of the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Malaysia, having considered the Second Amendment to the Agreement Establishing the ASEAN Promotion Centre on Trade, Investment and Tourism, hereby accepts the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, this Instrument of Acceptance is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia;
