## **INSTRUMENT OF ACCEPTANCE**

**WHEREAS** the Agreement Establishing the ASEAN Promotion Centre on Trade, Investment and Tourism was signed in Tokyo on 22 December 1980 by the duly authorised representative of the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand;

**WHEREAS** the Second Amendment to the Agreement Establishing the ASEAN Promotion Centre on Trade, Investment and Tourism was adopted on 20 June 2024 by the Council of the ASEAN-Japan Centre; and

**WHEREAS** Article XXI, paragraph 3, stipulates that acceptance by the Members of amendments to this Agreement shall be effected by the deposit of instruments of acceptance with the Depository Authorities;

**THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND**, having considered the aforesaid Amendment, hereby confirms and accepts the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, this Instrument of Acceptance is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

**DONE** at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 18<sup>th</sup> day of July in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Sixty-eight of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Twenty-five of the Christian Era.
