

INSTRUMENT OF ACCEPTANCE

WHEREAS the Treaty on the Southeast Asia Nuclear Weapon-Free Zone was signed at Bangkok on 15 December 1995 by the States Parties, including the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand, and entered into force on 27 March 1997;


WHEREAS the Addendum to the Treaty on the Southeast Asia Nuclear Weapon-Free Zone, amending Article 1(a) of the Treaty to include the territory, continental shelf and Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of Timor-Leste within the definition of the "Zone," was adopted on 25 May 2025 by the Commission for the Southeast Asia Nuclear Weapon-Free Zone and was subsequently deposited with the Depository State on the same day; and

WHEREAS Paragraph 1 of Article 2 of the Addendum stipulates that the Addendum shall enter into force 30 days after the receipt by the Depository State of the seventh instrument of acceptance from the States Parties;

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND, having considered the aforesaid Addendum, hereby confirms and accepts the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Acceptance is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

DONE at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 31st day of July in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Sixty-eight of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Twenty-five of the Christian Era.
